


SUNDAY SCHOOL Online Lesson & Activities November 29, 2020


Our first activity, below, is this week's mystery message that follows out second scripture reading, Mark 13:24-37.

Use the code below to discover the hidden message.








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A sample of the completed coloring page is below. This uses ripped paper, but you can also paint or color as you choose. Please turn the following page for your template and enjoy.











To create your 3D advent wreath, first decorate a paper plate using the leaves and berries on the last page of this document. Using green paper, paint, marker, or crayon for the leaves and red for the berries is encouraged. This will be the base for your Advent Candle display. Next, cut the peace, hope, love, and joy candles out. Color the flame and the candles. Then wrap then as a cylinder and glue together at the tab. Each week during advent, when we light a candle in church, you can follow along and attach your 3D candle to your wreath.
